

Annual Meeting, Election of Officers and Awards

The Annual Meeting of the Club is held in May of each year. The purpose of the meeting is to present reports to the membership on club activities, elect members to the Board of Governors, and elect officers. Family and Comprehensive members in good standing aged 18 or older are entitled to one vote each. A Family membership is entitled to one vote only. Votes may be cast in person or by proxy, but a proxy must be in writing and must be accepted by the presiding officer before the voting begins.

The nominating committee selects candidates for the Board of Governors and the officers, and their names are mailed to the members before the Annual Meeting. Other nominations may be made from the floor at the Annual Meeting.

Trophies and Awards

The **Henry W. Kenarny** Award is presented annually to the skater judged to have shown the highest achievement during the season.

The **Lisa Webster** trophy is awarded to the dancer who performed the best at the Princeton Open Competition.

The **Ida Atchison** Award is presented to the free style skater who received the highest marks at the Princeton Open Competition.

The **Ed Godwin** Award is presented each year at the Annual Meeting to the most improved adult skater.

Most Improved Awards are also presented to young skaters in Free Style, Dance, and Moves-in-the-field.

The **Oleg Stroukoff** Trophy is presented to the highest placing adult dance couple at the Princeton Open Competition.
